- 1. All above Consultant position is purely on contractual basis for 1 year or availability of fund, whichever is earlier, with annual review of performance. It may be further renewed depending upon the performance of the consultant and further availability of funds and requirement of the assignment.
- 2. The services of such consultants shall be governed by the approved Consultant Policy of JSLPS.
- 3. Numbers of position may increase or decrease based on requirement of the project.
